Said Council does hereby appoint and set the Public Hearing date of July 11th 2024, at 7:00 p.m. at the Council chambers in Nashville, Michigan, when said Council shall meet and hear objections to said vacation, discontinuance or abolishment and a copy of this resolution shall be published at least seven (7) days in advance of such meeting one (1) time in the Maple Valley News and a copy of this resolution shall be posted in the Clerk's Office of the Village of Nashville, Michigan.
