ORDINANCE # 3-13-2025

Council Member Felder, supported by Council Member Page, moved the adoption of the following ordinance:

An ordinance to preserve the public health and prescribing certain powers and duties of the board of health of the Village of Nashville, Michigan (Ordinance #33) to amend CHAPTER 3. HORSES, CATTLE, HOGS AND FOWL; and add SECTION 4.

THE VILLAGE OF NASHVILLE ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Amend Ordinance No. 33 CHAPTER 3. HORSES, CATTLE, HOGS AND FOWL. That Ordinance No. 33 CHAPTER 3. HORSES, CATTLE, HOGS AND FOWL is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

CHAPTER 3. HORSES, CATTLE, HOGS, FOWL, DOGS AND OTHER ANIMALS.

SECTION 4. No person owning or having possession, charge, custody or control of any dog shall intentionally, or through failure to exercise due care, permit such dog or other animal to defecate on any public or private property, unless such person immediately collects and properly disposes of all such fecal matter; provided, however, this section shall not apply to guide dogs for the visually handicapped and aid dogs for the physically handicapped.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be published in accordance with state law and shall become effective twenty (20) days after its adoption or upon its publication, whichever occurs later.
